

"Laissez les bons temps rouler!" is a Cajun expression meaning "Let the good times roll!" This phrase is heard often in New Orleans during Carnival Season. Carnival begins on January 6 (Epiphany), the official end of the Christmas season and kicks off Carnival season in New Orleans. Although some people say Carnival and Mardi Gras interchangeably, they are actually different things. Carnival is a time to eat, drink and be merry before the rigorous fasting and sacrifice during Lent. Carnival is filled with parades, balls and other celebrations leading up to Mardi Gras, which is French for "Fat Tuesday." Mardi Gras Day is the day before Ash Wednesday, signifying the end of the Carnival season and the start of Lent. Many cities (especially those with large Catholic populations) like New Orleans are famous for their Mardi Gras. FRESNO is one of those cities. The Fresno Dixieland Society is presenting 4 Days of celebration (Sounds of Mardi Gras) featuring great music and fun. Beside the tons of music ranging from New Orleans Jazz to Swing to Zydeco to Rock and Roll, there will be a Parasol Parade, the Coronation of Mardi Gras King and Queen, a Masquerade Party and Costume Parade, as well as a SWING dance. The Putting on the Ritz Parade will celebrate the famous dance—THE CHARLESTON. Don't miss the special tribute to High Sierra Jazz Band's bass man and vocalist—Earl McKee. This will be held on Friday in the Vendor Room from 4-5 PM. So much great music and fun activities, it should make for a happy and enjoyable weekend. Don't miss it. 
